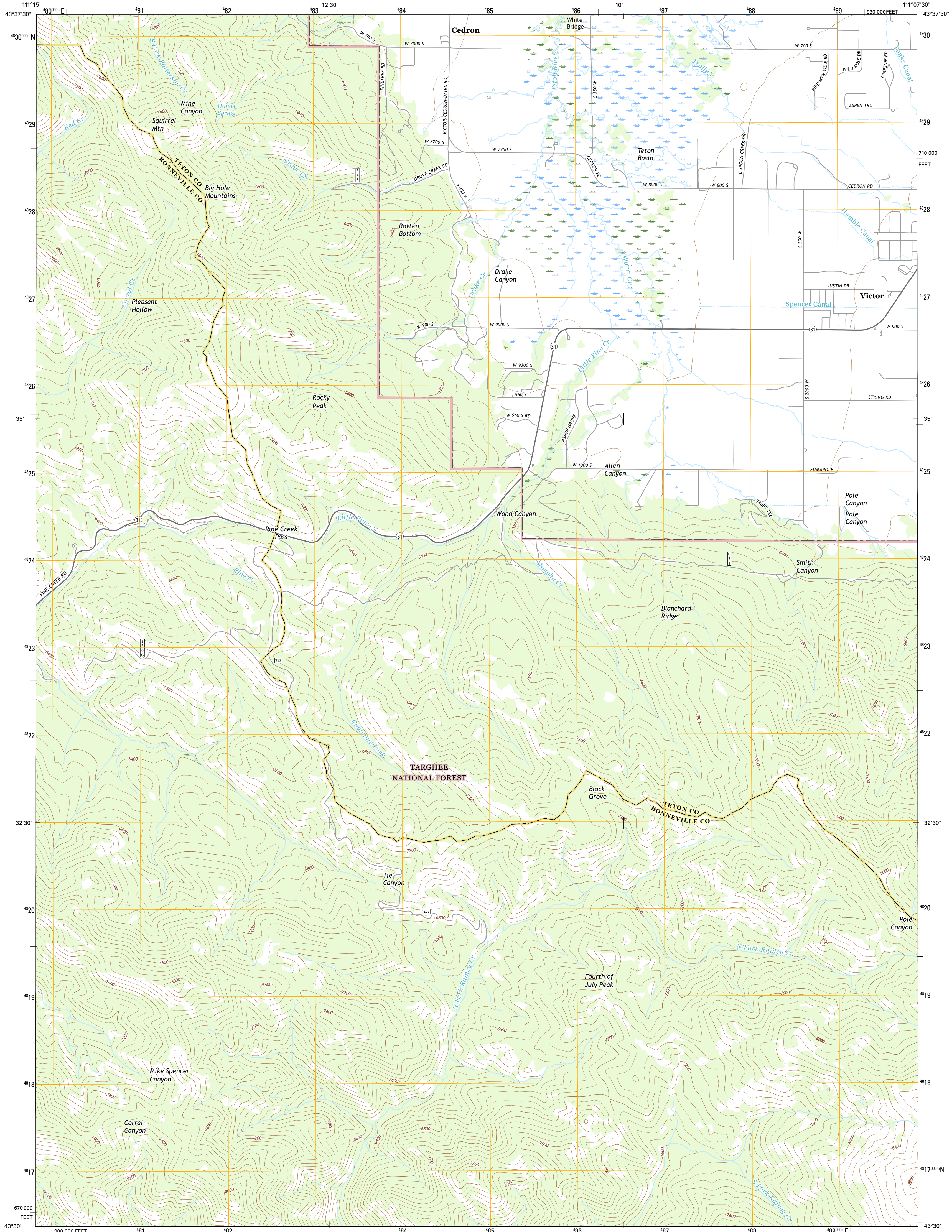

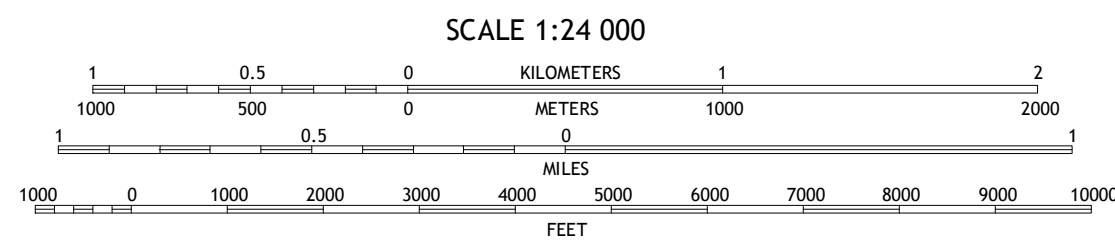
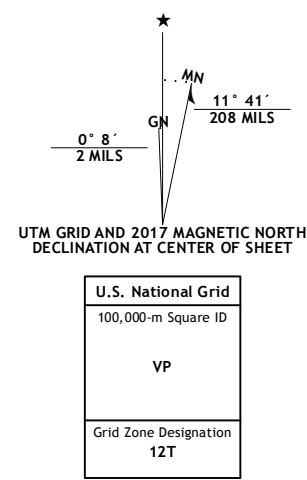
FOURTH OF JULY PEAK QUADRANGLE
