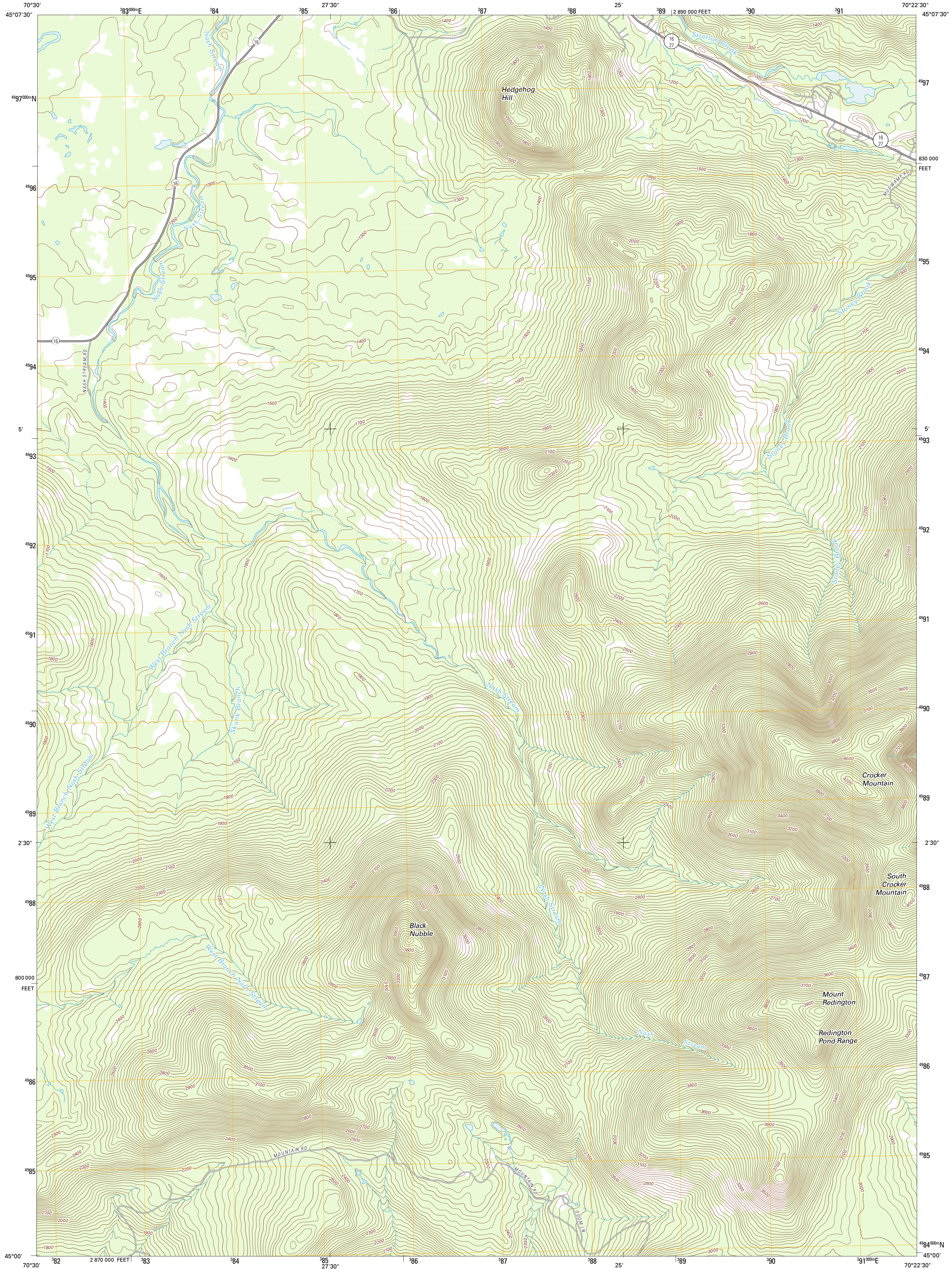

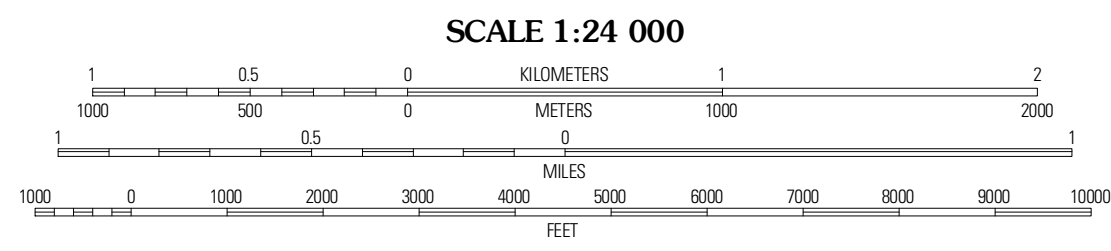
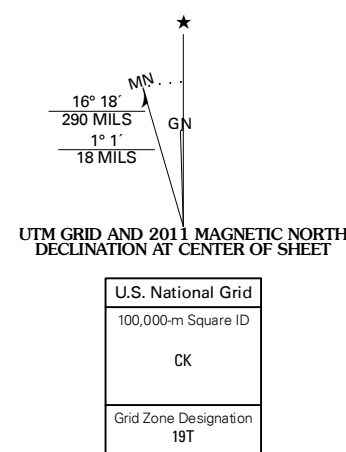


BLACK NUBBLE QUADRANGLE

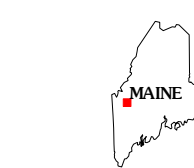

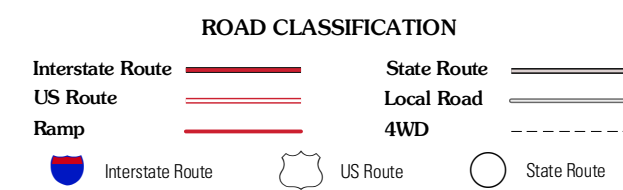
