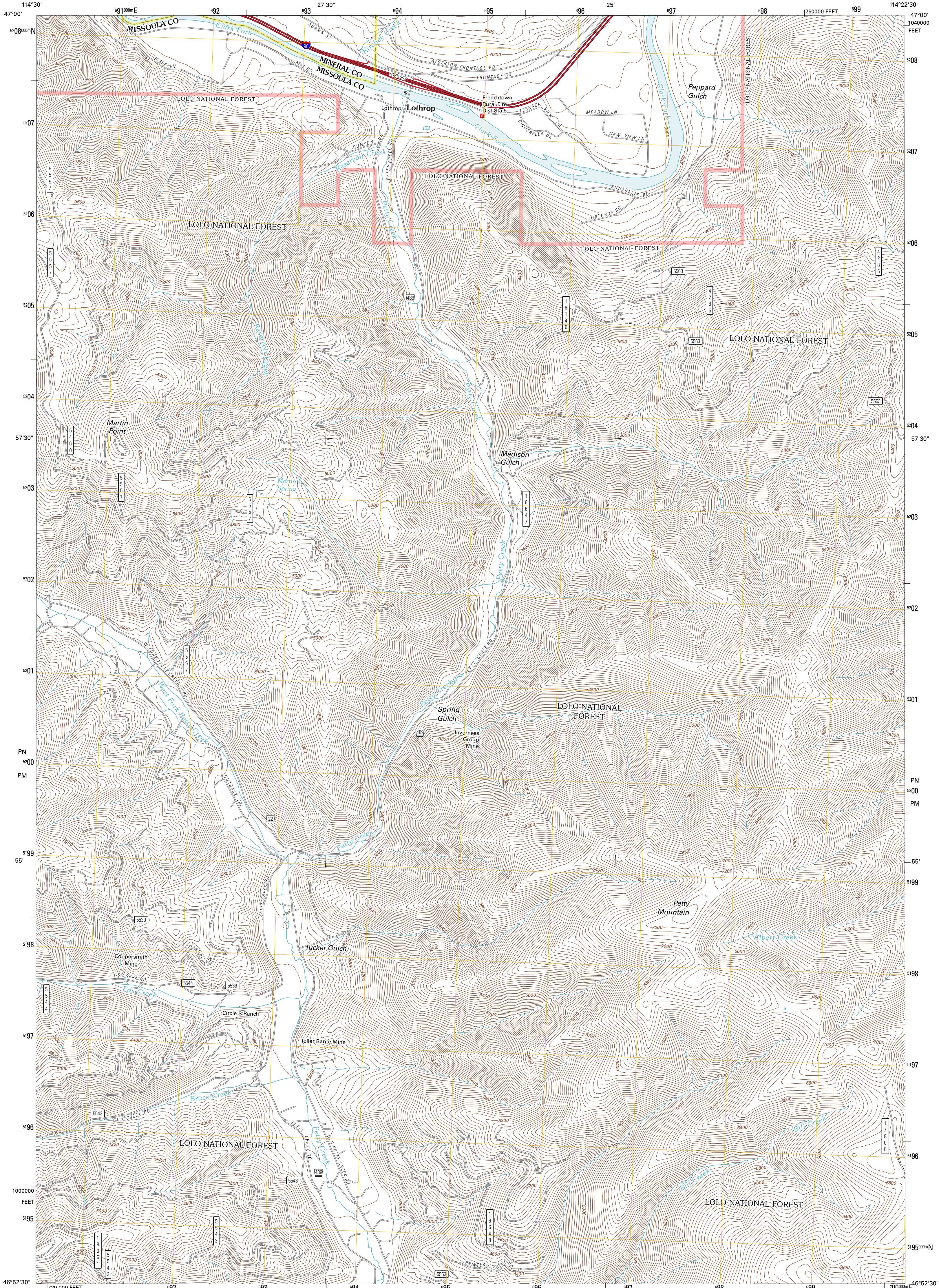

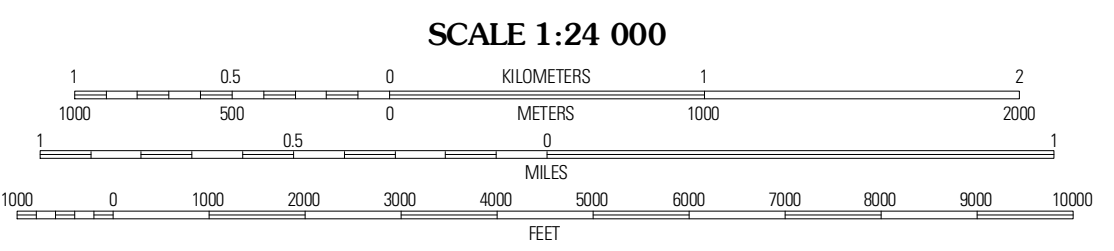
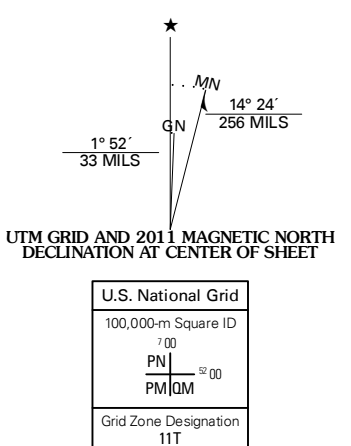


PETTY MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE
