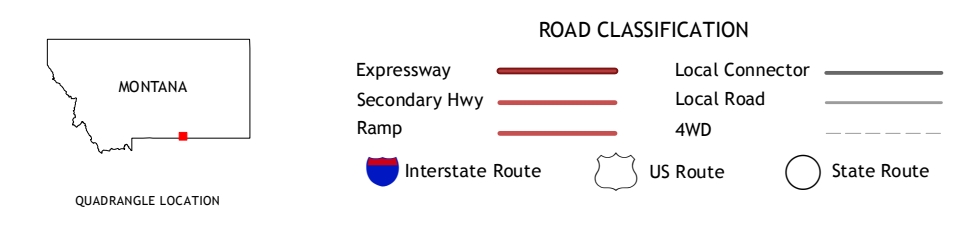
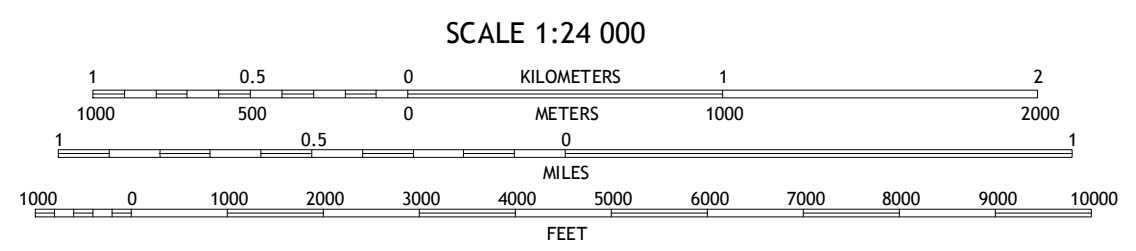
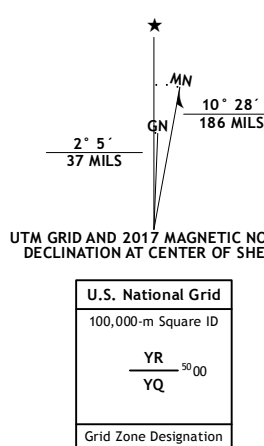
TWO POINT QUADRANGLE
