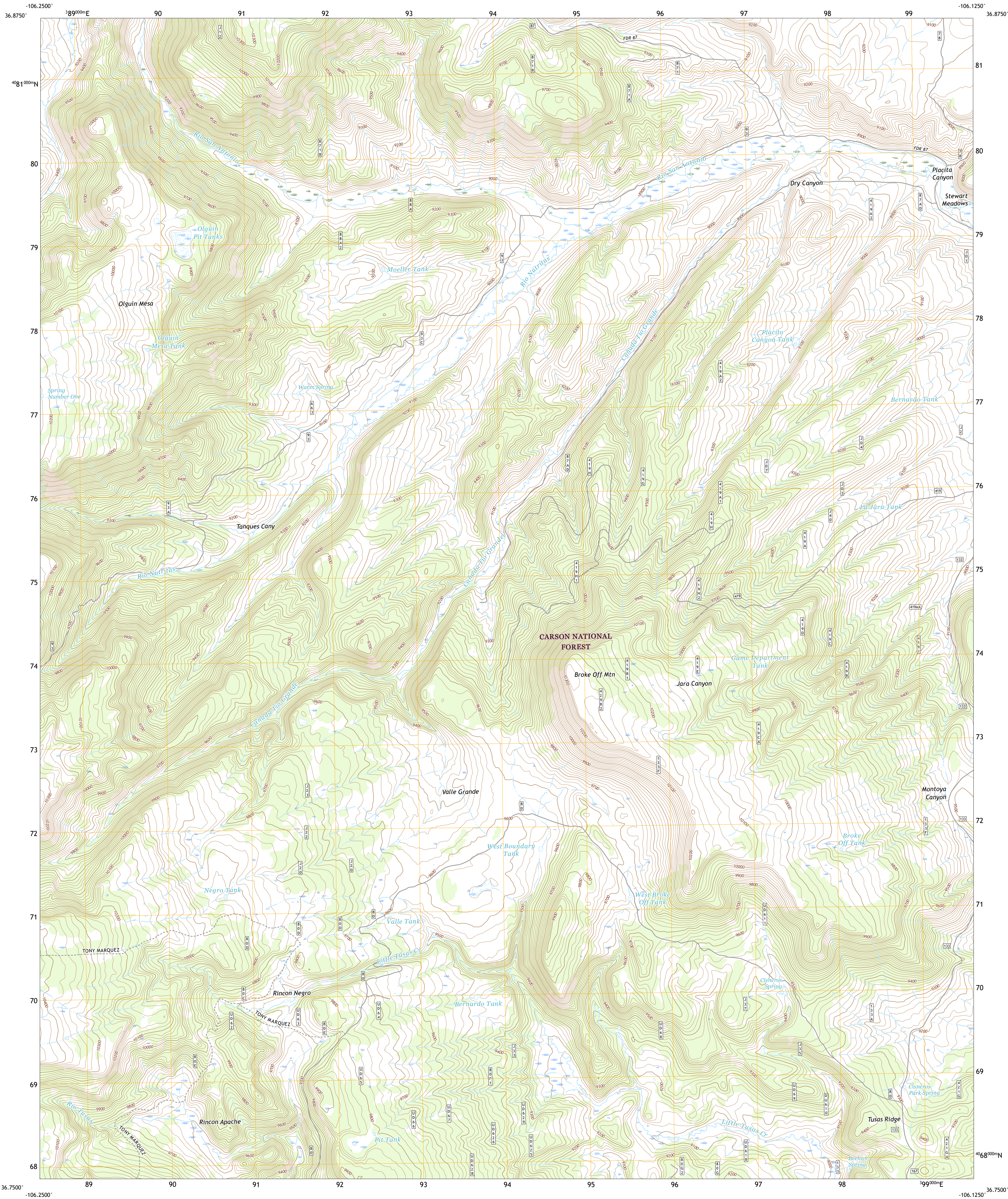

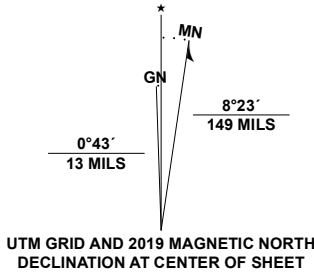


BROKE OFF MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE
