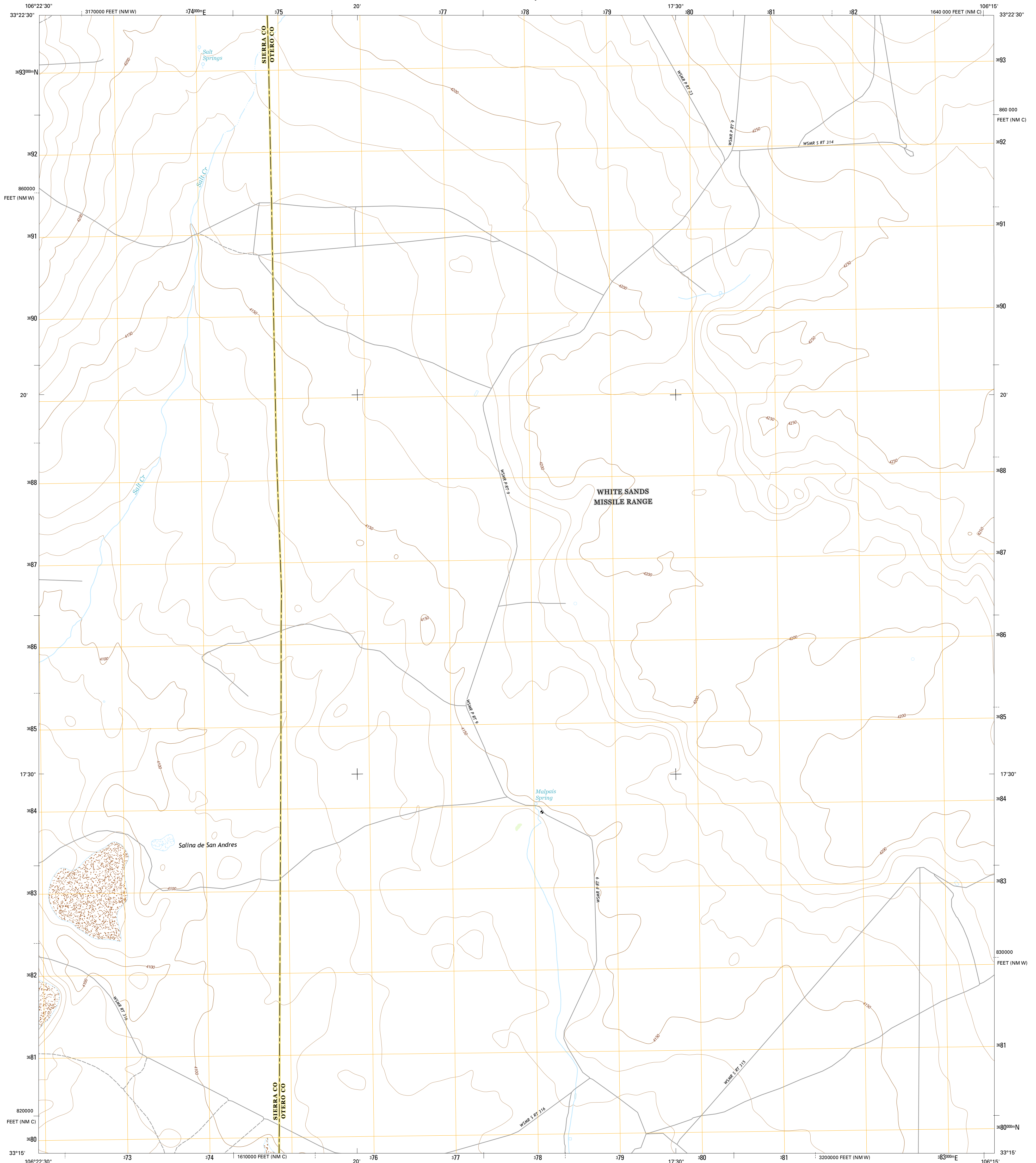

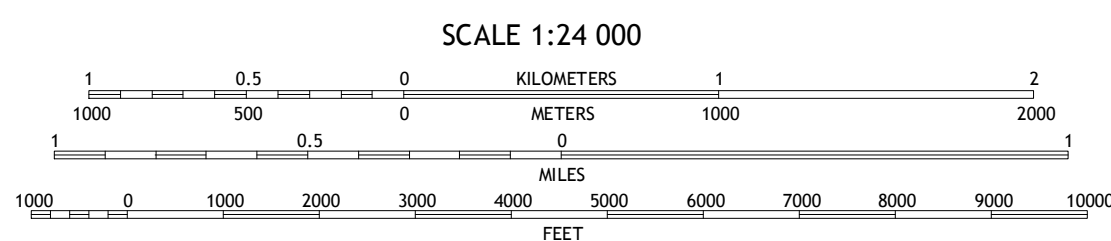
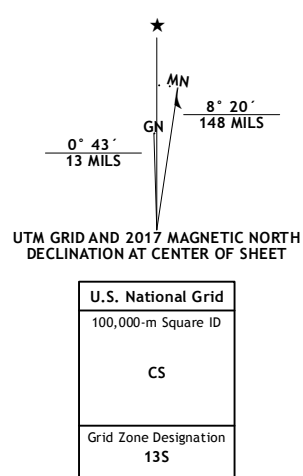
CAPITOL PEAK SE QUADRANGLE

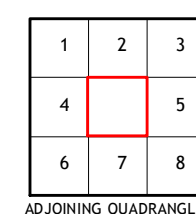
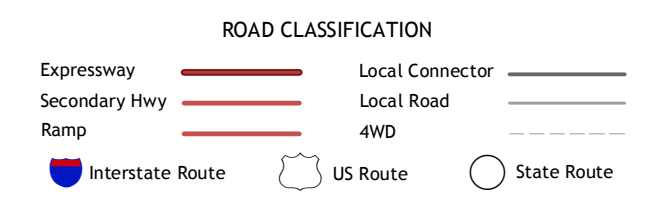
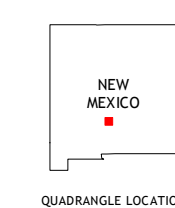
