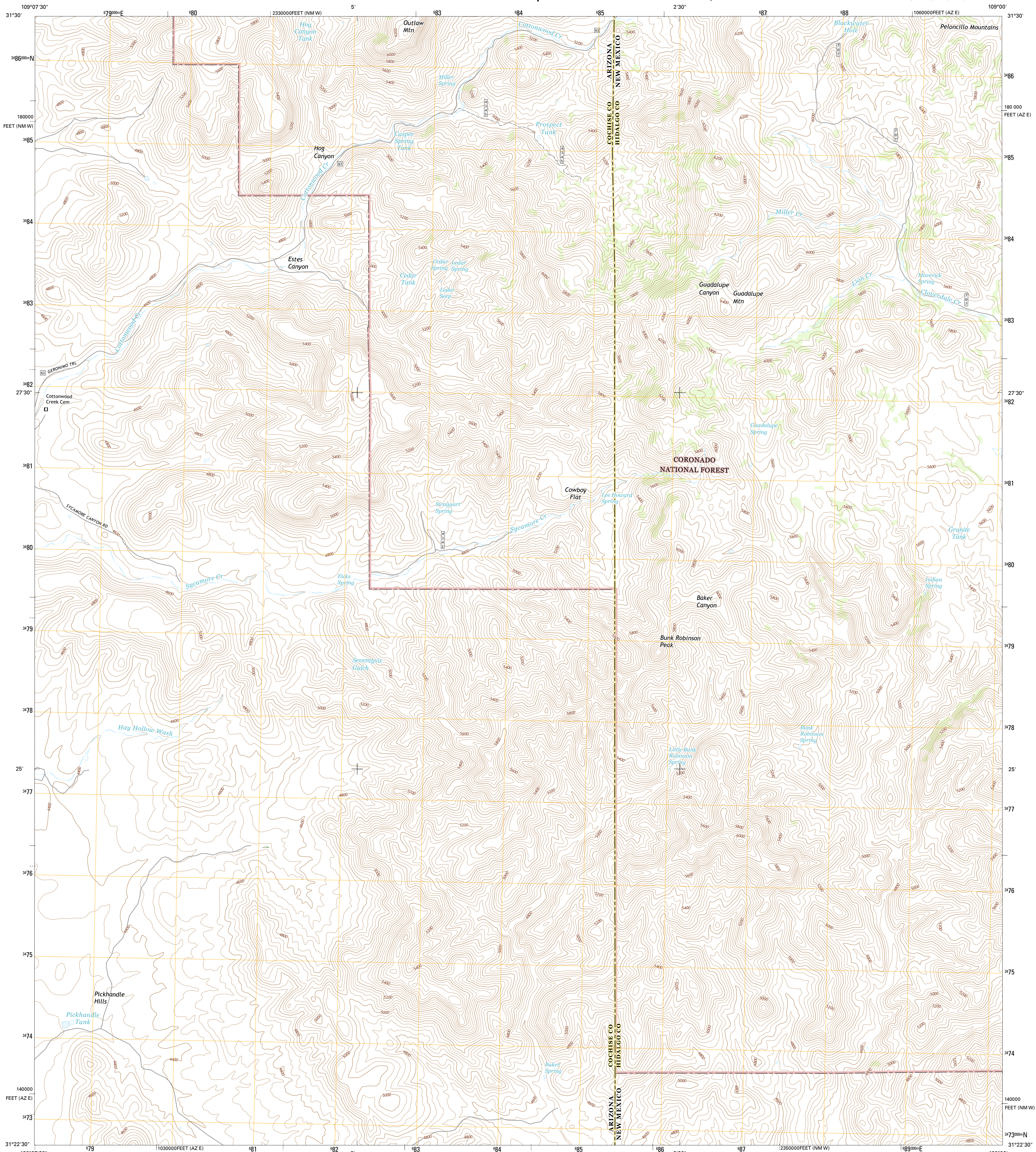

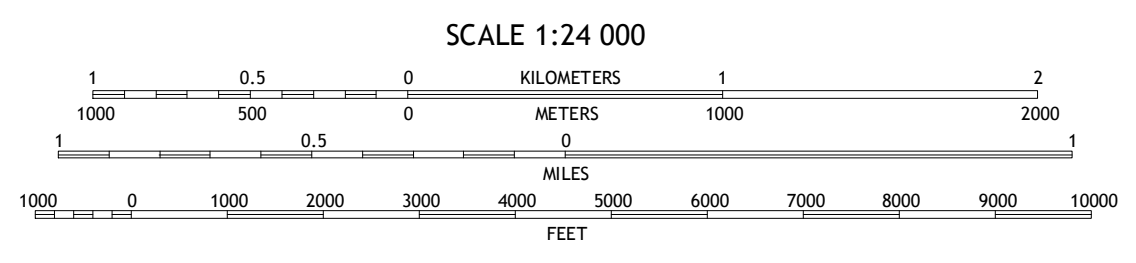
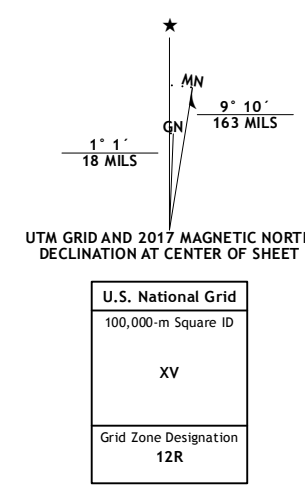
GUADALUPE SPRING QUADRANGLE
