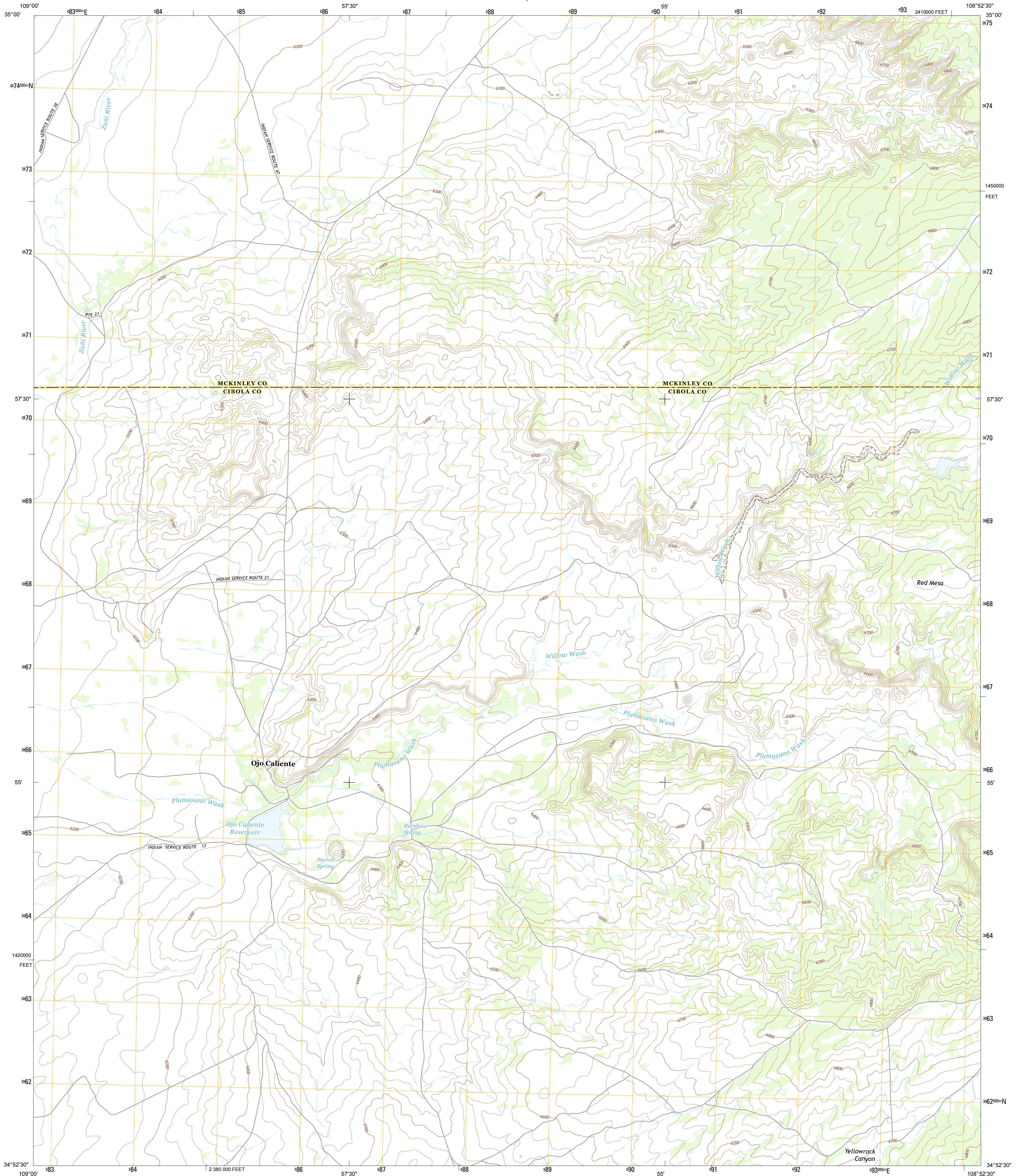

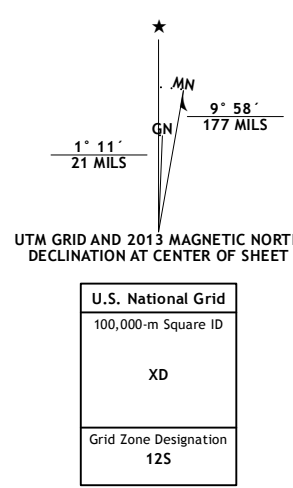
OJO CALIENTE RESERVOIR QUADRANGLE
