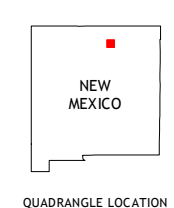
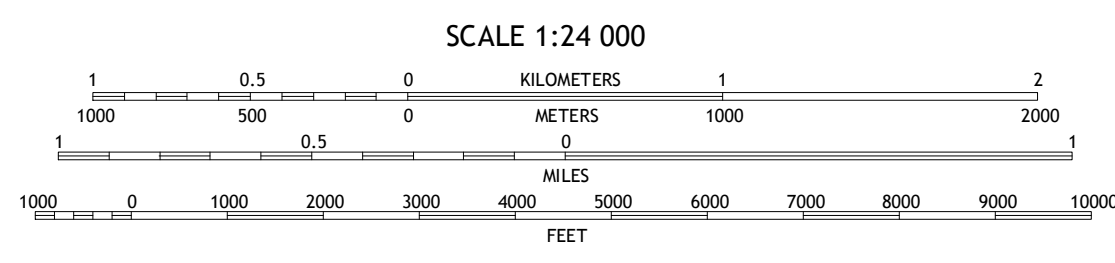
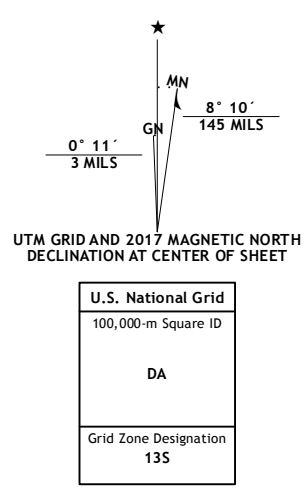
OSHA MOUNTAIN QUADRANGLE
