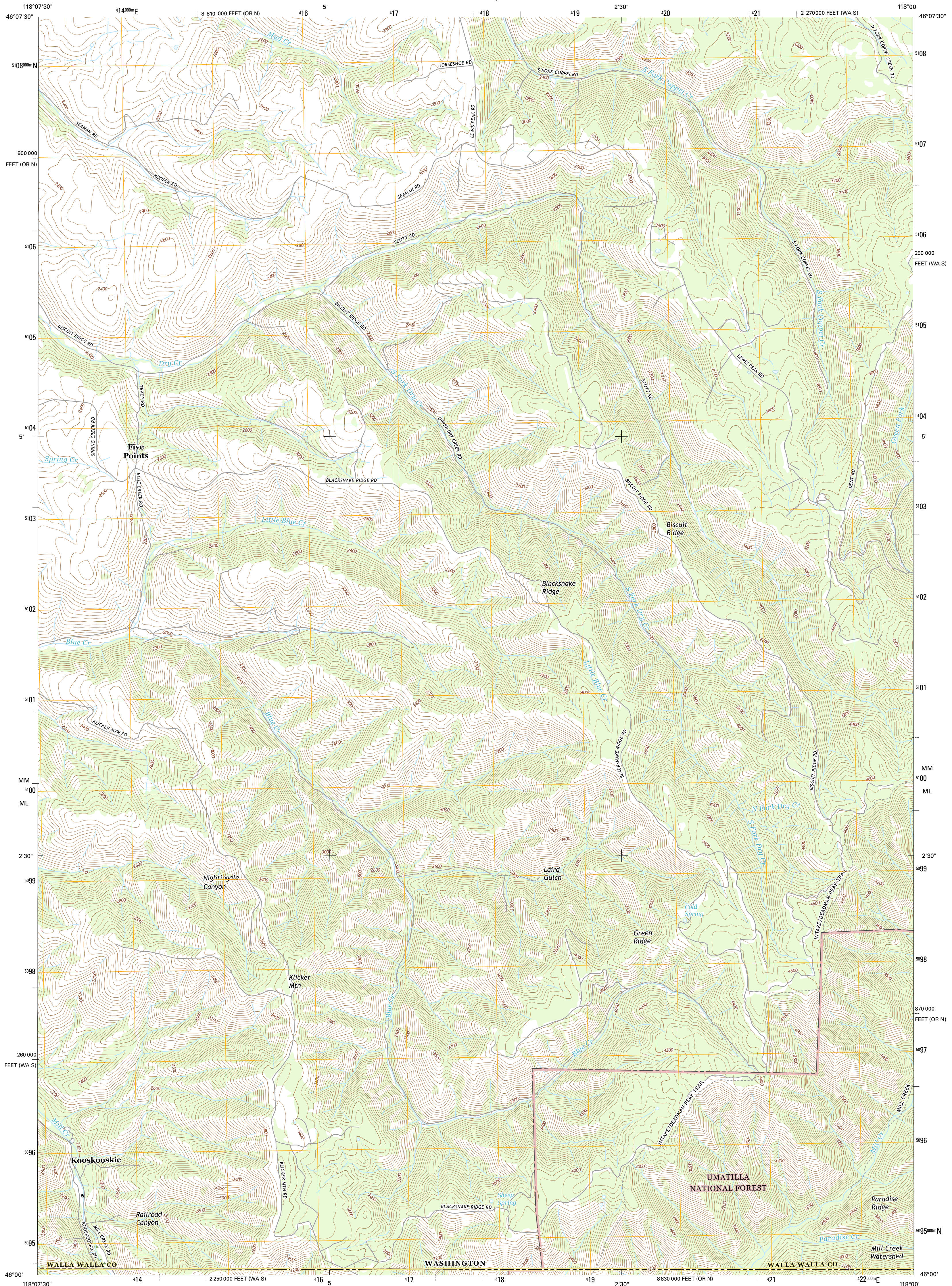

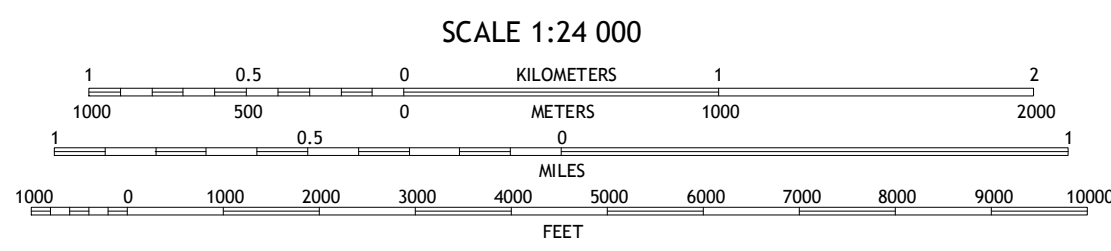
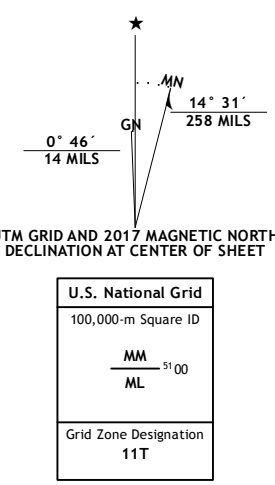
KOOSKOOSKIE QUADRANGLE
