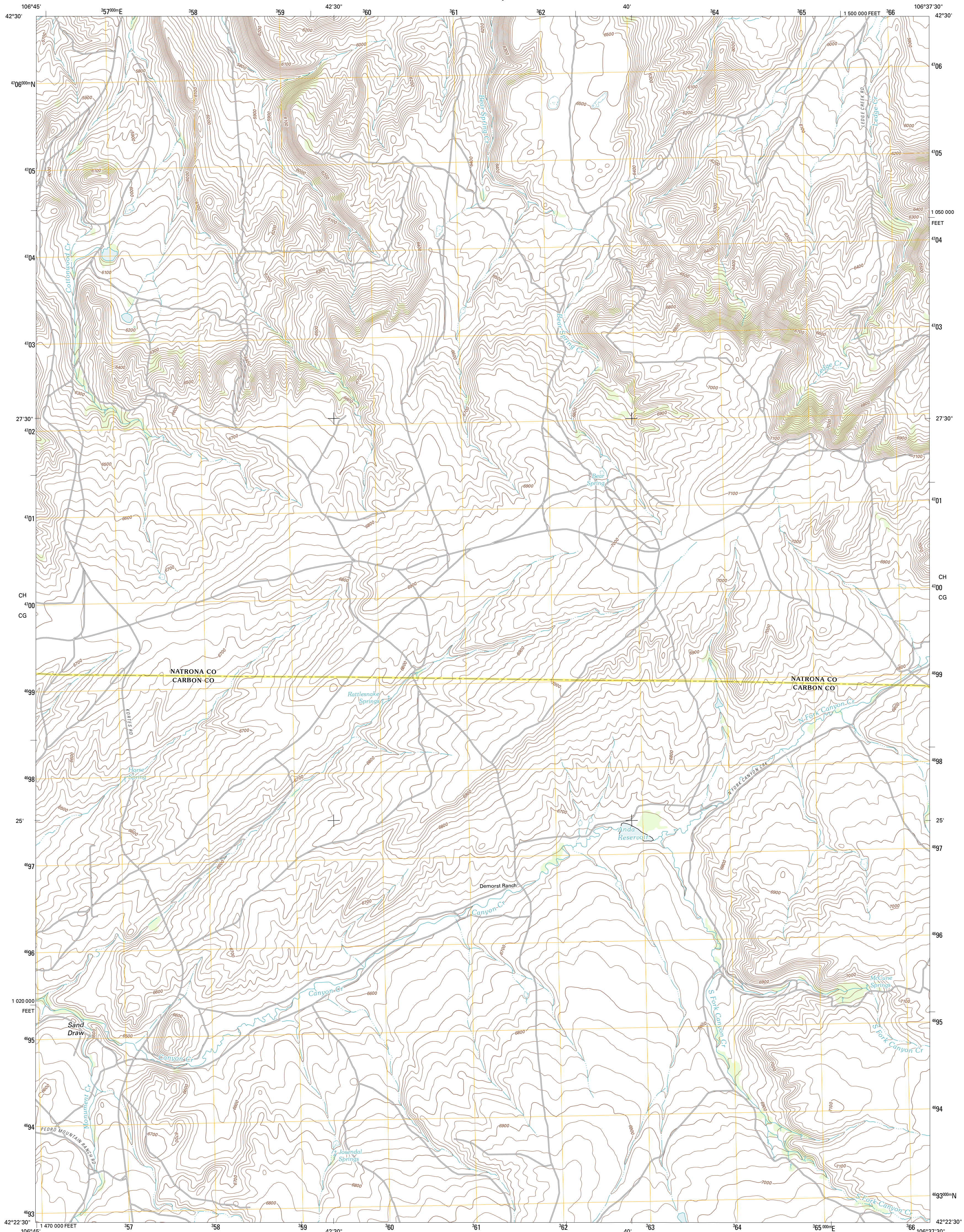

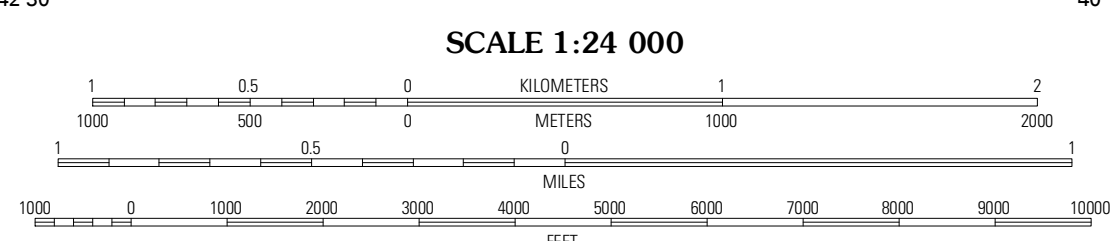
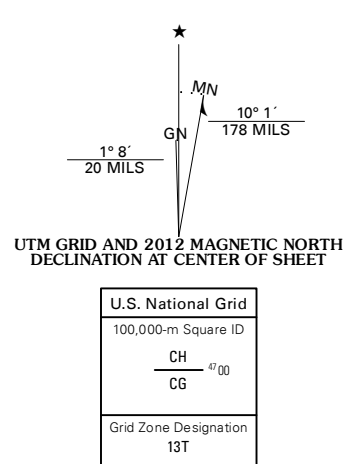


BEAR SPRING QUADRANGLE

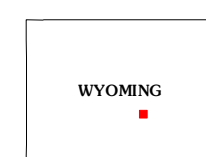

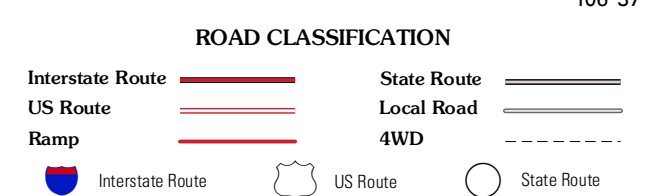
