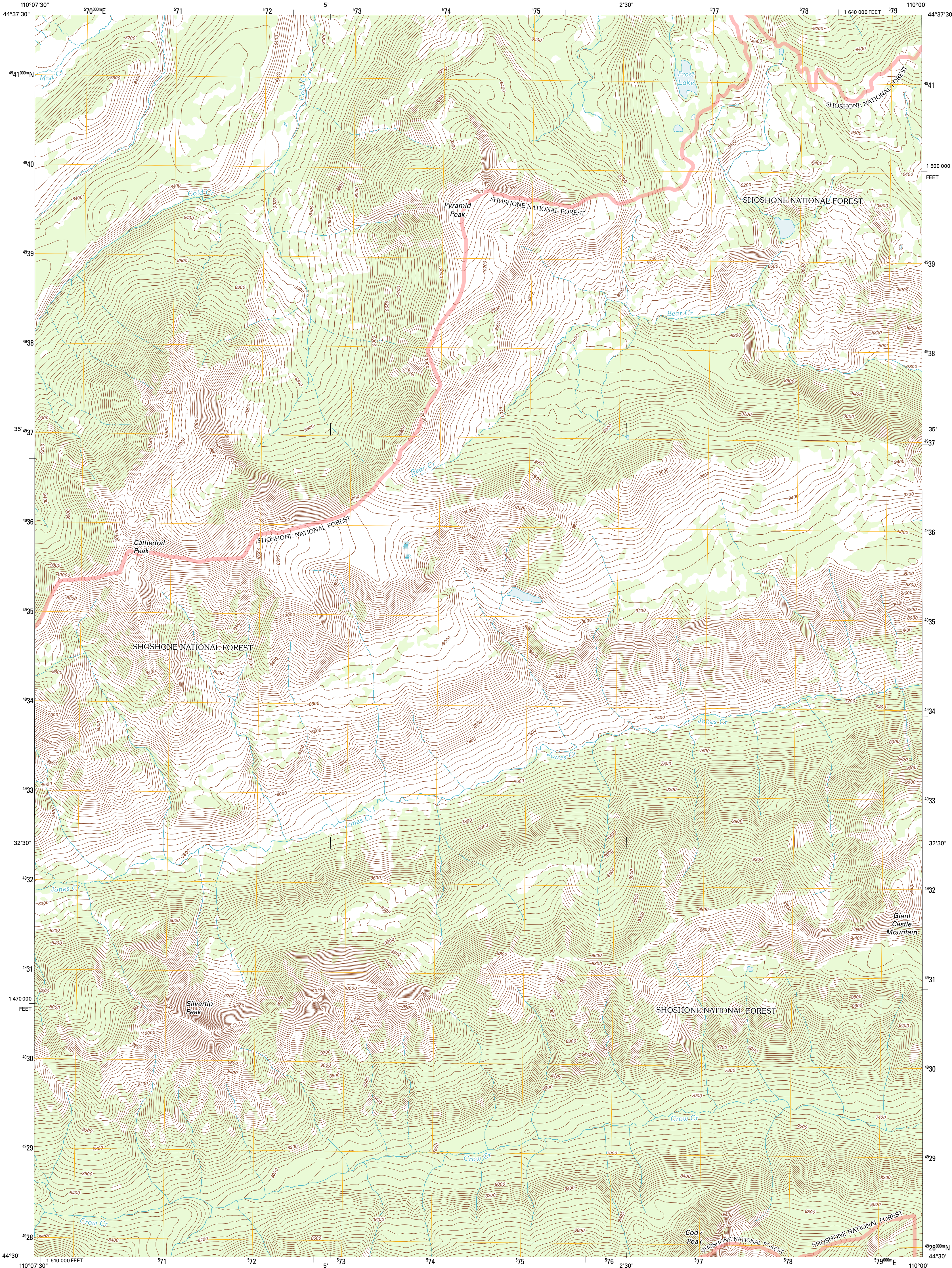

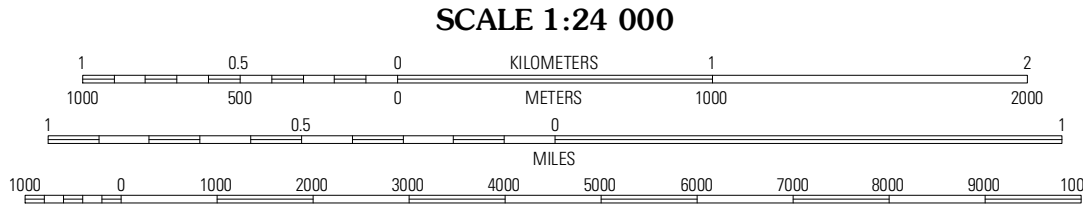
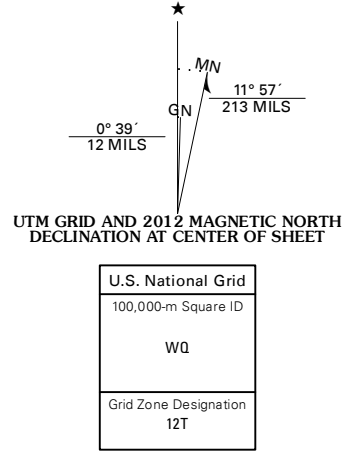


CATHEDRAL PEAK QUADRANGLE

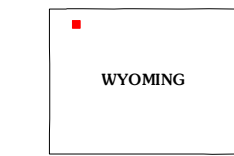

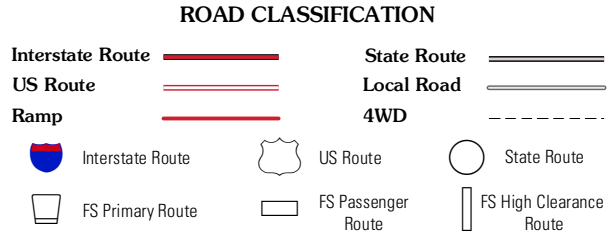
